



Dennis Gannon is a computer scientist doing research on the application of cloud computing in science. From 2008 until he retired in 2014 he was with Microsoft Research as the Director of Cloud Research Strategy. In this role he helped provide access to Azure cloud computing resources to over 300 projects in the research and education community. Gannon is professor emeritus of Computer Science at Indiana University and the former science director for the Indiana Pervasive Technology Labs. His research interests include cloud computing, large-scale cyberinfrastructure, programming systems and tools, distributed computing, parallel programming, data analytics and machine learning, computational science, problem solving environments and performance analysis of scalable computer systems. His publications include more than 200 refereed articles and three co-edited books. Gannon received his PhD in computer science from the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign and a PhD in mathematics from the University of California, Davis.
